Notice of a Public Hearing

The City of Salamanca will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, August 31, 2022 at 7pm in the court room of the City Municipal Building, for the purpose of hearing public comments on the City of Salamanca's community development needs, in relation to the results, recommendations, accomplishments, and outcomes of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funded City of Salamanca Board of Public Utilities Water Study. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR) and has made available to eligible local governments approximately \$49 million for the 2020 program year for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG funded Salamanca Board of Public Utilities Water Study, and will allow for citizen participation in the development of future plans related to the results of the Water Study and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternate proposals. Comments on the CDBG program or results of the Water Study will be received at this time.

The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart 1 of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. The location of the hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities. Written comments may also be submitted to the City Clerk until August 30, 2022.
